There will be fun activities (e.g. trials by sports clubs and associations, creative workshops for children and recreational zones) and plenty of networking opportunities in 'hyggelige' surroundings. The target group is international citizens (adults as well as children), who are curious to explore Danish culture, lifestyle and specific offers that can help them settle in Denmark and kick-start a good life.

Participation is free and you can attend one or both days. You can participate with a stand in the exhibition area and/or you can offer to host a talk, workshop, or other activity.
